The South Washington County School District (ISD 833) has partnered with Youth Service Bureau, Inc. (YSB) to have a Chemical Health Specialist working in the high schools.

The Chemical Health Specialist, **Matt McCune, MA, LADC**, will provide direct chemical health support services to students and families at the four high schools – SWAHS, Woodbury HS, East Ridge, and Park. - **Confidential one-on-one support** for students who use substances, have a history of substance use, and/or are impacted by others' substance use, such as family members or friends.
- **Support groups**, such as concerned persons and sober support (offered depending on student need)
- **Family sessions** regarding youth substance use with focus on connecting families to resources
- **Parent and staff consultation**
- **Chemical Health Screenings and assessments**
- **Referrals** to outside resources and follow-up support

Matt's Schedule:

- Due to distance learning, Matt is currently meeting with students virtually via Google Meets or Zoom. Scheduling with students will take place on home learning days at a time between 8:00am and 4:00pm that works best for the student.
- Matt will be present at SWAHS on Tuesdays and Wednesdays, times dependent on which students are available.
- Matt is open to alternative ways to meet that may be more convenient for students and families.

Students and parents may reach out to Matt directly to set up a meeting or they can let teachers, counselors, or other school staff know they'd like to utilize Matt's services.
